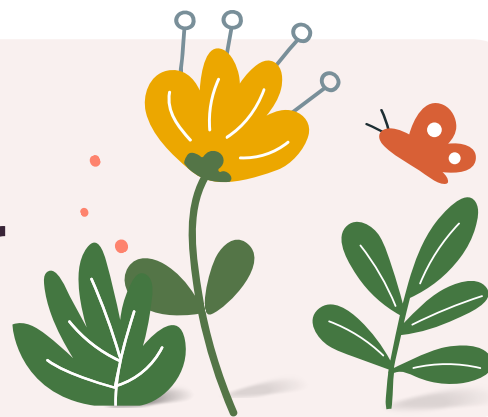

Legislative Amendments

On April 5th, 2025 there were changes made to the Registered Nurses and Registered Psychiatric Nurses Regulations. NPs now have the legislative authority to perform a psychosocial intervention and to order MRIs. RNs and RPNs can now accept an order for drugs and certain screening/ diagnostic tests from pharmacists, RN(AP)s, and RPN(AP)s. RPNs are also able to perform a psychosocial intervention without an order. The amended legislation can be viewed [here](#).
